Footnotes

REACH ONE MORE was content to follow the pace set by FROM THE ASHES racing outside that one, moved to challenge into the far turn, was roused briefly nearing the lane then drew off under a comfortable hold in the lane. FROM THE ASHES moved to the front and established position just off the inside, continued on a clear lead to late backstretch, continued with the winner through the far turn then could not match strides in the lane. SKWHIRL dropped back off the early pace racing three or four wide, moved up through the lane but could not menace. PATS HIGH LIFE saved ground while stalking the pace to the far turn and tired. LARRYLARRYLARRY stalked the pace from four wide to make a mild bid through the second turn and up the backstretch then tired. CASE ON ICE saved ground and failed to threaten. BLUMIN ATTITUDE followed the pace from three wide for a half and tired.
