COP GOT EVEN bobbed for a couple of steps leaving the gate while showing in front, dueled from inside ZENIA'S STORM throughout and continued on gamely to keep that one at bay through the stretch. ZENIA'S STORM dueled from outside the winner throughout and could not get by in the lane. MR. INTENSITY stalked the pace from three wide to bid into the far turn but could not go with the top pair. CO MACK failed to offer a bid racing along the inside. REAL QUIET JET was not a threat. DAKOTA CASH was caught in tight quarters at the start and failed to threaten racing out from the rail. RAJA GOLD was away slowly, trailed throughout and returned lame.
