A FAIR AFFAIR stalked the pace, raced three deep and was no match for the winner. SHINY SAND DOLLAR was unhurried early, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and made a mild late gain. HANNIBAL BAY pressed the pace and tired readily. BLUMESDAY was slow early and never menaced. STORMY LAD raced far back and never threatened.
