MORE NO forced the pace outside MS. BELLA to the far turn, slowly edged clear on that bend then was under steady urging the remainder to draw off through the lane. MS. BELLA made the pace inside the winner to the far turn and could not match strides in the final three-sixteenths. GO TIL DAWN saved ground throughout and was just up for the show in the closing stride. ANTI VERSARY stalked the pace outside the top pair throughout, could not keep pace after three-quarters and lost the show in the closing jump. BOOTIN AND SCOOTIN was always back, as was AMEEA FROST and OUR DANCE.
