UP 'N BLUMIN tracked the pace from outside MISSY CAN DO to challenge nearing the far turn, dueled that one the remainder and was slowly inching away late in a game run while establishing a new track record. MISSY CAN DO showed her usual good speed to move clear on the first turn, dug in as the winner challenged going to the far turn, dueled the remainder then could not go with that one in the final sixteenth while giving a game run. BUTTER CRUNCH saved ground to move nearest the top pair through the far turn but could not close the gap. DRESS RIGHT was three or four wide on the first turn while lacking speed and moved up late outside while not a threat. MY HOBBY raced out from the rail and lacked a rally. NIKKI NINE chased the top pair from three wide to the far turn and tired.
