MISSY CAN DO showed her usual good early speed to move clear and gain the inside going to the first turn, repelled the early bids of UP 'N BLUMIN then kept that rival safe in the lane. UP 'N BLUMIN forced the pace outside the winner, lost ground through the far turn then was coming again late but could not run that one down. STARLORD saved ground and bested the others but could not keep pace with the top pair. MAGIC TRUMP saved ground and lacked the needed rally. KEROSENE PROSPECT was not a factor racing four wide. STEAL MY KISSES stumbled badly at the start to nearly fall, recovered to chase the pace from three wide and tired.
