RUN ZOOHA RUN set all the pace from the outside and held gamely to be clear under all out pressure. CATTLE BARON was allowed to settle early, moved up three wide at the eighth pole and finished second best. THREE ELEVENS was allowed to settle early, moved up five wide into the upper stretch and made a mild late gain. OKIE WILDCAT was slow early, saved ground and gained ground in the final stages. HIGH INVESTMENT was slow early, raced four wide in the lane and never was a serious threat. Y RECAZ was unhurried early, saved ground and never menaced. THANKS MR G pressed the pace and tired. THE STRAW MAN failed to sustain a bid.
