CRAFTMASTER stalked the pace, moved up four wide nearing the eighth pole and finished gamely to just get up under all out pressure. FORWARD BERNIE set all the pace along the inside and finished gamely to just miss. GENTLEMAN SCHOLAR pressed the pace while racing between horses and finished willingly to the wire. NAFIR'S LAD was allowed to settle early, saved ground and made a mild late gain. BRICK CREW was slow early, raced four wide and had no late winning bid. MFAZI stalked the pace from the outside, raced five deep and weakened a bit in the final stages. ALKINOOS was unhurried early, raced four wide and had no response. HIGH FLEET showed little. SECO EXPRESS was slow early and never menaced. COUNT COUP was hustled along and tired.
