S C CLOUD CAT showed good early speed, raced three wide in the lane and edged clear in the final stages under steady pressure. MOVIN THE CHAINS showed good speed from the inside and finished second best. SAMMY WILL TELL stalked the pace from the outside, raced four wide into the upper stretch and had no late winning bid. BOXACROSS stalked the pace, angled to the inside soon after the start and had no late winning bid. FRIDAYNITE IN BOYD was bumped at the start, raced four wide into the upper stretch and made a mild late gain. INVISIBLE EDGE was slow early, raced five wide in the lane and never was a threat. TURBO TIGER showed little. IKE TIME was outrun. EARLY EXPECTATIONS was bumped at the start and had no response.
