FIRST CLASS BRASS sped clear soon after the start to opened a commanding lead in the first turn, continued on an easy lead racing along the inside then was roused briefly through midstretch while maintaining a comfortable margin to the wire. EARLY FINAL came in to bump with a rival at the break then was caught in tight quarters and steadied into the first turn, rallied along the inside then angled three wide into the lane and made a mild late run at the winner. ONE LUCKY DEVIL leaned into the side of the gate to come away a bit slowly, moved inside to chase the winner then could not save position late. BLAKE RATTLENROLL bumped with a rival at the break then drifted wide in the first turn and had no rally. MR. PINSTRIPE came in on a rival into the first turn and failed to threaten the remainder while three and four wide. SEASIDE LINKS was not a factor racing four wide.
