LARRYLARRYLARRY settled back off the early while saving ground, moved to contention then was caught in traffic and boxed in from the top of the far turn through that bend into the lane, altered course inward to split foes midstretch and moved clear in a good run. ARMY OFFICER rallied through the far turn to move outside the winner nearing the lane, could not match strides with that one but just gained the place late. HUXLEY HALL moved up four wide to bid into the far turn, contested the lead through that bend then could not hold position late. SWEET PETE dueled from outside WHOLELOTTA RICHTER on the pace early, continued to vie into the stretch and weakened late. WHOLELOTTA RICHTER ducked in and hit the gate at the start, dueled from inside SWEET PETE to late backstretch and tired nearing the lane.
