BLUMESDAY stalked the pace, raced three deep, gained command entering the far turn and drew off to be well clear under a steady hand ride. ZOOHA'S LAST BABY pressed the pace along the inside and was no match for the winner. SNEAKIE PETESKI was in tight at the start, raced four wide and made a mild late gain. MYWILDIRISHDREAM was squeezed back at the start, saved ground throughout and made a mild late bid. SENATOR BERI vied for the lead along the inside and tired. THUNDER N SMOKE came in sharply at the start and was bumped, raced three deep and had no response in the drive. KENDY stalked the pace from the outside and faded. B C EXPRESS was a bit rank around the first turn and was pulled up.
