**Footnotes**

BABY CLAM stalked the pace, exchanged bumps at the three eighths pole, built a clear lead into the upper stretch and held gamely under a steady hand ride. HERO'S DANCER was allowed to settle early, moved up three wide at the eight pole but was no match for the winner. CLASSY'S REVENGE showed good early speed, came in at the three eighths pole, exchanged bumps with Baby Clam, forced Black and Fancy to take up sharply, raced just off the inside through the far turn, came in at the eighth pole forcing Wild sherry to take up sharply and weakened the final eighth of a mile. SMOKEN SALLY was allowed to settle early, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and never was a serious threat. WILD SHERRY stalked the pace, took up sharply at the eighth pole and tired thereafter. BLACK AND FANCY was allowed to settle early, made a good bid towards the leaders while racing along the inside, was forced to take up sharply by a rival drifting in, raced towards the inside in the stretch and never threatened thereafter. RUNSANDYRUN stalked the pace and tired. BOUND TO LOVER pressed the pace and tired. GOLDEN VICTORIA was off slowly and remained back throughout.
