Footnotes

BRAHMS SONG vied from inside HOT BISCUIT throughout and slowly edged away late. LYNNIES TREAT saved ground while following the pace, edged clear through the far turn then angled out through the lane and moved up but could not threaten the winner. HOT BISCUIT contested the pace from outside the winner into the lane and weakened in the final sixteenth. MY FLICKA saved ground and lacked a solid closing response. TRUE LIGHTNING settled outside off the early pace, moved four and five wide in the far turn and lacked a rally. LATIN MISSILE settled back off the pace racing four wide, angled in going to the far turn and failed to threaten. ALMOST SILVER stalked the pace from three wide to make a mild run at the leaders midway up the backstretch and weakened. SCHMOOZING weakened after stalking the pace three and four wide. CAUGHTINTHEMIDDLE was always outrun. STEP IT UP STEPH chased the leaders from four wide in the first turn and tired.
