SWEET BOY stalked the pace, moved up three wide and finished gamely to be clear under all out pressure. JUNGLE RAJ stalked the pace, raced three wide through the far turn into the upper stretch and finished second best. MISSION ENVISIONED was allowed to settle early, moved up four wide at the eighth pole and had no final winning bid. BOOTDIM was unhurried early, moved up five wide into the upper stretch and made a mild late gain. PRIME PRINCE pressed the pace and gave way. FIVE O'CLOCK SHADOW dropped back early, raced towards the inside throughout and never was a factor. AVELINA'S TICKET failed to menace. CITY LAKE set all the pace and tired readily the final eighth of a mile. CALIN trailed throughout.
