DOUG was on the pace from inside his stablemate while out from the rail, edged clear into the far turn then drew off in the lane under steady handling. WIRE SEEKER ducked out at the start to bump with a rival, angled three wide in late backstretch to bid into the far turn then could not go with the winner in the lane while able to hold clear for his position. ONE LAST YANKEE was off a step slow then shuffled back as the place horse came outward, moved to striking distance in late backstretch while moving four wide and lacked a further response. ROSS contested the pace from outside his stablemate for a half mile and tired. ZOOHA THE KING was bumped and squeezed back at the start then lacked a rally while saving ground. HI FLYIN COWBOY saved ground and was not a factor. FIGHTIN THE BOOZE chased the pace for a half and gave way.
