BAD BOY AIDAN stalked the pace from the inside, moved up three wide at the eighth pole and finished gamely to be clear under all out pressure. C. O. STORM set all the pace from the inside and finished second best. HAPPY GUY was allowed to settle early, moved up along the inside and finished willingly to the wire. CITY SLICKER was unhurried early, moved up five wide into the upper stretch and made a mild late gain. WORKIN' THE CROWD was slow early and never threatened. R R GOLD raced four deep and never menaced. SAINTLY SON showed little. KING TYMATT failed to sustain a bid. BOLD PARTISAN was injured and had to be vanned off.
