### Footnotes

HESO dueled on the pace from inside SIR MAGIC MAN to late backstretch then was challenged by FIRST CLASS BRASS into the far turn, continued with that one then edged clear turning for home, was roused briefly and drew off through the closing sixteenth. FIRST CLASS BRASS settled back of the early leaders to stalk in good position, moved four wide to challenge into the far turn, dueled the winner through that bend then could not match strides in the lane. THE NUTZ came out a bit and steadied in the first turn, moved out to rally three and four wide and bid through the far turn but had no late response. RECAST saved ground and made a mild late run through the lane. SIR MAGIC MAN dueled from outside the winner to the far turn and tired. MR. PINSTRIPE was not a factor racing outside.
