SPRING BLUES set all the pace and held gamely to be well clear under all out pressure. FIRE UP THE BELL was allowed to settle early, saved ground down the backstretch, moved up three wide at the eighth pole and finished second best. C O STEPHEN stalked the pace, raced four deep into the upper stretch and had no response. SCENIC SHADOW showed little. BEGG'S pressed the pace and gave way. KIMURA failed to sustain a bid. ELEVEN GAGE raced far back and never threatened.
