DAKOTA REBEL stalked the pace from the inside, moved up four wide at the eighth pole and finished gamely to be clear under all out pressure. STREAK set all the pace while racing along the inside and finished second best. CHARISMIC STYLE stalked the pace, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and finished willingly to the wire. WINDY RUSH stalked the pace, saved ground throughout and had no late winning bid. POWDER RIVER CAT raced three deep and never was a factor. W DAVID P was bumped at the start, raced four wide in the lane and never was a factor. RIDGE JUMPER took up sharply at the start, raced five wide into the upper stretch and never was a serious threat. WET FAST showed little. RED MONKEY failed to menace. RICK'S WONDERBOY was hustled along from the outside and tired.
