Footnotes

SHOOT THE RAPIDS set all the pace along the inside and held gamely to be clear under all out pressure. CEE'S DANCIN' CAT pressed the pace from the outside, raced three wide in the lane and finished second best. TOP GUN TIME came out at the start, checked nearing the quarter pole, saved ground and had no late winning bid. MISTER SUH was bothered repeatedly at the start, took up at the quarter pole and had no late kick while experiencing a troubled trip. RINGATSEVEN was slow early, raced six wide into the upper stretch and made a mild late gain. T J'S SLEW P stalked the pace from the outside, took up at the quarter pole and weakened in the stretch. RED RELAUNCH exchanged bumps early, raced four deep and never was a factor. ICHI ONE saved ground and never menaced. PENNINGTON J. R. was bumped hard at the start, checked nearing the quarter pole and never was a threat. CASH COW KID reared at the start and raced far back throughout.
