FLASHY MIKE pressed the paced, gained command through the far turn and prevailed in the drive under all out pressure. HOWARD COUNTY HANK was unhurried early, moved up three wide at the eighth pole and finished second best. FUTURE FUN hit the gate at the start, raced four wide into the upper stretch and finished willingly to the wire. STRING OF DIAMONDS raced evenly and had no rally. NINE K ENIGMA set all the pace from the outside and tired. CATTLE BARON showed little. AT A BOY RUSS was up close early, dropped back readily and pulled up in distress.
