AN ALLOWANCE STAKE FOR NEBRASKA-BRED FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. No nomination fee with \$50 to enter and an additional \$50 to start. Weights, 3-year-olds 118 lbs., Older 123 lbs. Nonwinners of \$15,000 twice in 2010 allowed 3 lbs., of \$15,000 in 2010, 5 lbs., \$9,000 in 2010, 7 lbs. Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in allowances. High weights preferred, on the scale. Total earnings in 2010 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. Owner of the first finisher will receive free breeding season to Nebraska Stallions specified at a later date. Closed Saturday, June 12 with twelve nominations. (S)

Footnotes

NAYBORHOOD AFFAIR contested the lead from inside GRACIE JANE through the opening three furlongs, moved clear in the second turn and widened a bit racing up the backstretch, responded when challenged going to the far turn and held well through the lane to remain clear. PLAER'S TRUMP saved ground through the opening half mile while in good position, moved out to rally three and four wide heading up the backstretch, bid outside the winner through the far turn then could not get by that one through the lane. DEPUTY'S WHIRL saved ground while trailing early, moved three wide up the backstretch to rally then came back inside entering the far turn, awaited room nearing the lane then swung back out and closed but was too late. JANE OF ARCADIA stalked the pace racing three and four wide to make her rally through the far turn then could not produce the needed late response in the drive. BLACK AND FANCY saved ground in reach of the pace but lacked a final closing response. CONSUMERS YUZUMER saved ground while towards the back of the field to late backstretch, continued inside then angled four wide into the lane and made a mild late bid. GRACIE JANE contested the pace from outside the winner through the first turn, continued with that one while under a hold to the second turn, settled through that bend and had no response in the final quarter mile. SUNDAY DANCER was four and five wide through the first turn while outside the leaders, gave way heading up the backstretch and was eased into the stretch while completing the course.
