DOUG showed good early speed, raced along the inside throughout, came out at the sixteenth pole causing Not So Irish to check and finished gamely to the wire under left handed urging. DAN DEE DART was allowed to settle early, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and finished gamely to the wire. SWEET BOY was slow early, moved up five wide into the upper stretch and finished willingly to the wire. NOT SO IRISH pressed the pace, checked at the sixteenth pole and weakened in the latter stages. DOUGLAS EXPRESS was slow early, raced five wide at the eighth pole and never was a factor. BENJAMIN E. failed to sustain a bid. SODA POP SAM pressed the pace and tired.
