**Footnotes**

AWESOME'S CAPE made the pace racing out from the rail, was joined from his inside by HANNAS BOY I. M. into the far turn, dueled that one into the lane to gain the advantage then held late as PRIME LAUNCH closed to be up by the narrowest of margins. PRIME LAUNCH settled back off the pace about three wide, rallied in the lane and missed by the narrowest of margins. HANNAS BOY I. M. was unruly behind the gate, got loose and ran off three-eighths of a mile prior to the start, causing a delay and a change of rider. With the new rider aboard the horse was once again unruly going to the gate and loaded riderless, then during the race gained the rail in the early going, vied for the lead from along the inside into the stretch and had nothing left late. BLACK BEAR BILLY bore out on the first turn then several times going up the backstretch, came back to the rail through the far turn and moved along the rail in the lane. FORT HUACHUCA stalked the leaders from three wide and tired. BLARNEY SLEW was not a factor. ZIP N BY was far back early. HOWARD COUNTY HANK reared and threw the rider at the start.
