CHAMPAGNEANDMONEY pressed the pace, moved up three wide into the upper stretch and finished gamely to get up in his final strides under all out pressure. SAMMY WILL TELL set all the pace along the inside and finished second best. DITDADIT was unhurried early, moved up three wide at the eighth pole and made a good late gain. PATH OF HONOR was allowed to settle early, saved ground and finished willingly to the wire. ROSS AND ROLL was bumped at the start, saved ground and never was a serious threat. MARIA'S CAT was slow early, raced four deep and never was a factor. LAUNCH RAGAN broke out, bumped at the start, raced three deep and never menaced. FARAWAY BEAU failed to sustain a bid. A. J.'S TURN was forced to take up at the start, raced three deep and never menaced. BUCK'S STRIDE stumbled at the start and raced far back throughout.
