TEN LIL INDIANS was allowed to settle early, moved up four wide and finished gamely to be clear under strong encouragement. FORTYFIFTHPARALLEL stalked the pace, raced three wide and finished second best. PLAER'S TRUMP was unhurried early, raced towards the inside throughout and finished willingly to the wire. SPICE SWIRL was unhurried early, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and made a mild late bid. BEADED was slow early, raced six wide into the lane and never was a serious threat. ZENA'S AFFAIR stalked the pace while racing four deep and weakened. DAZZLING SEVILLE raced well off the inside throughout, moved up seven wide into the upper stretch and never was a serious threat. EXTRA COIN dueled for the early lead along the inside and tired readily. DIAMOND DID IT dueled for the early lead from the outside and stopped in the final stages.
