WESTFEST saved ground throughout, launched his rally along the rail through the far turn then swung out entering the stretch to run down the leaders and prevail in the closing jump. SLEW LUCKY moved up three wide to join the leaders leaving the first turn, dueled from outside MISTER QUIGLEY the remainder then was caught at the wire by the winner. MISTER QUIGLEY disputed the early lead from outside GRAND CHEROKEE, continued on with SLEW LUCKY heading up the backstretch to duel that one the remainder then came up short in the blanket finish at the wire. NORTHERN INDIAN saved ground while following the early pace, rallied along the rail through the stretch and came up short in the blanket finish. GRAND CHEROKEE was sent up to challenge for the early lead and tired before going a half. ONE FINE AFFAIR trailed while three wide and had his rider lose whip midway of the far turn.
