LIGHT SWEET CRUDE showed good early speed while racing along the inside and finished willingly to the wire. C O BARQUEEN broke awkwardly, race four deep at the eighth pole and showed good late interest. HANNAHSLITTLEANGEL dropped back early, saved ground throughout and had final bid. SOUNDS BETTER saved ground throughout and never threatened. FORTYFIFTHPARALLEL showed little. PROSPECTORS ALYCAT was hustled along and tired.
