TRANSEPT'S AFFAIR stalked the pace from the outside, moved up four wide through the far turn into the upper stretch and drew off in the final stages to be well clear under all out pressure. KING FARHA was unhurried early, moved up four wide at the eighth pole and finished second best. COLOR OUT pressed the pace from the inside and weakened a bit in the stretch. GIN STINGER stalked the pace, raced four deep and had no final winning bid. HOLIDAY JUSTICE was slow early, saved ground and made a mild late gain. WORKIN' THE CROWD showed little. QUALITY MIRJAH stalked the pace along the inside and failed to respond. GO WEST BERT showed little. MY SON JORDAN showed good speed from the outside and faded.
