B G GOLDEN TIME showed good speed from the inside and drove clear in the final stages. SARATOGA EMBER was unhurried early, moved up six wide at the eighth pole and finished second best. LYNAE DAWN stalked the pace, raced towards the inside and had no final winning bid. BRAHMS SONG was allowed to settle early, moved up five wide into the upper stretch and had no late winning bid. QUEEN ME was slow early, moved up five wide at the eighth pole and never was a serious threat. BEAUTIFULBROWNEYES failed to respond. THIS TIME BABY was hustled along from the inside and tired. LYNNIES TREAT was slow early and never menaced. ABDUCTED LADY failed to sustain a bid. LUMBER QUEEN stalked the pace and tired.
