STORMAN pressed the pace from the inside and finished gamely to be clear under all out pressure. JAYGEE SURVIVOR stalked the pace, raced four wide at the eighth pole and finished second best. DREAM ON BOYS was unhurried early, raced three wide and made a mild late gain. RACK OF BLACK was slow early, raced four wide into the upper stretch and was no real threat. DAKOTA CASH took up at the start and never menaced. NOBLE DE FENCE bobbled at the start, raced three wide and never menaced. REDONDO BEACH vied for the early lead, his back heels were clipped at the three sixteenths pole and tired thereafter. CONNIE'S MAN stalked the pace, raced just off the inside nearing the three sixteenths pole, clipped heels, lost his irons briefly and tired in the lane. NO PROB BOB stalked the pace, raced three wide down the backstretch, got stopped at the three sixteenths pole after Connie's Man clipped heels and was not asked thereafter.
