DANT stalked the pace from the outside, moved up five wide at the eighth pole and finished gamely to get up under strong pressure. B G TOP YANKEE showed good early speed from the inside and finished gamely to just miss. SILVER WAR stalked the pace, raced along the inside and finished willingly to the wire. ALPHABET ACADEMY was shuffled back at the start, moved up six wide into the upper stretch and gained ground in the final stages. FIREMAN JERRY saved ground and never was a serious threat. RAIN FEATHER was slow early, raced five deep in the lane and never menaced. THREE RUDYS was hustled along and tired. MARCUS AURELIUS was hustled along, raced in tight quarters nearing the eighth pole and faded in the lane.
