Footnotes

SWEN RAY stalked the pace, gained command along the inside down the backstretch and prevailed in the drive under all out pressure. EWING TIGER was bumped at the start, raced eight wide into the upper stretch and closed fastest to just miss. CATTLE BARON was allowed to settle early, moved up seven wide in the lane and finished willingly to the wire. TANNA GOLD stalked the pace, raced five wide at the eighth pole and had no late winning bid. CRAFTMASTER stalked the pace from the outside, raced four deep and had no response. KING TYMATT pressed the pace from the outside and gave way. FERGISSHARKATTACK was bumped at the start, raced in tight quarters at the sixteenth pole and weakened a bit in the final stages. COYANOSA stalked the pace, raced in tight deep stretch and never was a serious threat. FORGOT THE TIME was hustled along from the inside and tired.
