

FRIDAYNITE IN BOYD gained a short lead along the inside through the first turn, continued with the winner through the far turn into the lane then could not match strides late while holding well clear for his position. STRAWBERRY MILK angled out to move three wide heading up the backstretch, continued outside and lacked a final closing response. LIL BUDDY steadied in the opening furlong from between rivals, moved up two and three wide heading up the backstretch, angled in through the far turn and lacked the needed late response. RAINY DAY AFFAIR was angled in early to cause congestion, stalked the pace in good position to the far turn and lacked a closing response. C O RINGO checked along the rail in the opening furlong as a rival came in, saved ground and failed to mount a bid. B'S TIGER was not a factor racing outside. BUDDHA BUBBA flashed early speed from four wide and gave way.
