BELOIT KAN TOO set all the pace along the inside and drew off in the final stages to be well clear under all out pressure. SELECTED pressed the pace from the outside, raced three deep and finished second best. SCHWARTZBEWITHYOU stalked the pace, saved ground throughout and had no final winning bid. COMMAND CAT saved ground and never was a factor. RARE AN WINDY was slow early, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and never was a serious threat. POWER SWEEP LEFT stalked the pace, raced four deep and had no response. NEWTONS THEORY was slow early and never menaced. B G GIFT EXCHANGE stalked the pace and tired.
