WALLSTREETGANGSTER reared and left himself at the break with about ten lengths to make up, rallied to catch the back of the field before going a quarter mile, moved out to rally three wide in the far turn, came five wide for the drive and made a strong late run to prevail in the closing jump. MEGAPUNCH stumbled at the start, quickly recovered to rush clear then floated out into the first turn while maintaining the lead, continued to lead into the lane then just failed to last in the closing jump. MFAZI rallied three and four wide through the far turn into the lane then had his rider lose whip deep stretch. NORTHERN INDIAN saved ground throughout and made a late run up the rail in the lane. ZENIA'S STORM prompted the pace from outside ZENIA'S STORM and weakened. SLEWS MOTEL was in good position just off the pace racing outside and weakened. THANKS MR G was in tight quarter just off the leaders heels into the first turn, raced just off the pace from along the inside and weakened.
