SOLID BLUE moved clear into the first turn racing out from the rail, shook off a bid into the far turn to kick clear again then was under mild encouragement to maintain the advantage. AVELINA'S TICKET was bumped between rivals and squeezed back at the start, angled out heading up the backstretch to rally four and five wide through the far turn into the lane and continued on willingly to gain the place. THUNDER CLUTCH broke inward to bump with a rival, stalked the winner from along the inside to bid into the far turn then could not sustain the run. TOP OF THE HERD moved up three wide while not a threat. LYNNIE'S GONE WILD broke outward to bump with a rival then came out entering the first turn, chased the winner from three or four wide and weakened. DAKOTA CASH was bumped between rivals and squeezed back after the break then failed to threaten while saving ground. THE BIG LOMBOWSKI broke outward and bumped with a rival then came in to bump another rival, lugged in during the opening quarter mile then was packed wide in the first turn as another rival was coming out, remained in reach to the far turn and tired.
