SCARFACE SAL raced five wide into the upper stretch and made a mild late rally. ANTI VERSARY stalked the pace, challenged nearing the eighth pole and hung in the lane. CANDY PINS raced three wide and had no excuse. SCAMP A DUDLE pressed the pace and tired. ALLIE SAIDEH failed to respond. COUNTRY PRINCESS raced wide throughout. ALL STAR CHARACTER showed good speed and tired badly.
