GRAND ON AFFAIR pressed the pace, raced three wide and finished second best. BELOIT KAN TOO set all the pace and weakened a bit in the final sixteenth of a mile. WIDE OPEN was unhurried early, moved up four wide and made a mild late gain. WARRIOR CAPE stalked the from the outside, raced four wide and weakened a bit in the drive. HAYN DAWG dropped back early, raced five wide in the lane and never was a factor. JAYEMBRO showed little. JACOB'S TIGER failed to sustain a bid. MINIMAL RISK was hustled along and tired.
