Footnotes

DOUG moved up outside MARCUS AURELIUS in late backstretch to challenge, dueled through the turn then continued well in the lane to hold safe. MARCUS AURELIUS moved to the front from the inside heading up the backstretch, dueled the winner through the turn into the lane and could not produce the needed late surge. CODY tracked the leaders from three wide and lacked a final closing response. TALENTED PLAYER was four and five wide through the turn into the lane and lacked a closing response. THE BIG LOMBOWSKI saved ground and was not a threat. LYNNIE'S GONE WILD lacked a rally racing three wide. CHIEF FAST CAT was just off the leaders to the turn while three to four wide and weakened. THUNDER CLUTCH stumbled at the break and never threaten from the inside. DAKOTA SMOKE was always back while three wide.
