Footnotes

CHOCOLATE DIVA pressed the pace, raced three deep and finished gamely to be clear under all out pressure. BRAHMS SONG was allowed to settle early, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and finished second best. RARE CRYSTAL pressed the pace, gained command down the backstretch and weakened a bit in the drive. CASH TREAT was unhurried early, saved ground throughout and made a mild late gain. ANNADACIOUS stalked the pace, raced three wide and had no final winning bid. PEACH MONEY dropped back early, raced four wide through the far turn into the upper stretch and never was a serious threat. DEPUTY'S WHIRL was slow early, moved up six wide at the eighth pole and never was a factor. QUEEN ME showed little. BURJ stalked the pace along the inside and tired. OH YOU SWEETEE showed good early speed and tired readily.
