Footnotes

WINFER saved ground while lagging towards the back of the field early, continued inside going to the far turn then worked his way through traffic to find an opening along the inside into the lane, closed determinedly and was up in the closing jump. RAIN FEATHER contested the lead from inside through the first turn, came out to the three path heading up the backstretch, continued well out in the track while on a clear lead then could not hold safe late. PLANTOBEREADY bumped with a rival at the break, moved up between rivals to bid into the far turn then could not produce the needed late run while three wide into the lane. MAJOR APPEAL saved ground while near the back early, moved up inside going to the far turn, angled out through that bend to be five wide into the lane and gained position while no threat. MYMY VEGAS was not a threat racing two to three wide. STILLWATER SLEW stalked the leaders racing out from the rail and tired. ROCK HARD WALLY drifted into the gap after the start and failed to threaten while four wide. TERM TRICK stalked the pace racing three to four wide and tired. RAINYDAYNIGHT was always outrun. ABEL WINAPRIZZE bumped with a rival at the break, gave way way through the far turn and was pulled up but walked off under his own power.
