Footnotes

MUSCADINE chased the pace outside GOTTA BELIEVE ME, drifted out when challenging for the lead entering the stretch, drifted back in when clear in midstretch and lasted under urging. STORMIN JERRY lacked speed, hugged the rail entering the turn, eased out in upper stretch, angled to the seven path in midstretch and closed late. DADDY'S GABS stalked the pace, moved up in the two path in upper stretch, altered course to the outside of MUSCADINE inside the eighth pole then failed to sustain his bid. HEAVENSTMURGATROID saved ground on the turn and was not a factor. GOLD CASTLE, five wide entering the stretch, had aim on the lead in midstretch then weakened late. HOLIDAY BOY dropped back on the turn, angled to the six path in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. ANZIO ADAM, wide leaving the backstretch, moved up entering the stretch and gave way in the drive. GOTTA BELIEVE ME, sent to the front, set the pace along the rail and faltered approaching the eighth pole.
