Footnotes

PLEDGE OF TRUTH , taken to rate three wide, edged closer into the far turn, came under pressure mid turn, bid three wide into the lane, brushed with HUNGER three sixteenths out, took over under right handed encouragement in mid stretch then steadily pulled away under a stiff drive. HUNGER leaned in at the break and bumped with RUN TYLER RUN, was corrected and tracked the pace two wide, bid under mild coaxing to take over after a half mile, was engaged by the winner leaving the quarter pole, came out a bit brushing that one in upper stretch, dueled past the furlong grounds, faded but was well clear for the place. TIME HAS COME stalked the early pace while saving ground, eased out around the turn, chased the leaders into the stretch but came up empty. TUBAL broke a step slow, was under a ride into the turn, swung five wide for the drive, made a bit of progress in mid stretch then flattened out. RUN TAYLER RUN bobbled at the break then was jostled between horses, dropped well off the early pace, was under pressure three wide mid turn, angled six wide for the stretch run but had no response. ESPIRITU LIBRE , bumped at the break, was sent up between rivals to take command, kicked clear and dropped to the rail, set the pace for nearly a half mile, kept on under urging to mid turn then faltered.
