WILLA OF TORONTO, unhurried off the rail, advanced four wide around the final turn, drew clear in mid stretch then held sway under drive. SALUTELOOT stalked the pace along the inside, eased out for the drive and closed gamely. TRIPLE PRO, outside, steadily advanced four wide nearing the quarter pole then faded in the final eighth of a mile. FAST QUADRANT, three wide down the backstretch, prompted the pace two wide the final turn, drifted out in upper stretch and tired. MY PETITE NICOLE, saved ground and went evenly. WILD GOOSE CHASE hesitated leaving the starting gate, raced three wide down the backstretch and second turn then tired. UNCONDITIONAL LOVE set the pace towards the inside and gave way in upper stretch. FRENCH PUNCH prompted the pace two wide and dropped back after five and a half furlongs.
