Footnotes

WONDER MON , between rivals into the first turn, prompted the pace three wide under a rating hold, took a short lead leaving the three eighths pole, moved clear entering the lane and widened under very confident handling. SKIP TO THE NORTH saved ground stalking a contested pace, eased out nearing the quarter pole and finished willingly to be clear for the place. BIG JOHN A. R. set a pressured pace in the two path, was headed leaving the three furlong marker then, held well to mid stretch then faded. CHANGING FUNDS was steadied off of rivals nearing the first turn, rated close up leaving the six furlong pole, angled to the rail mid way down the backstretch, advanced inside nearing the lane, angled out and finished with some interest. CAMISADO , bumped at the break, lost ground three to four wide and failed to respond. KEEPASHARPLOOKOUT , bumped at the break, settled back along the rail, swung out six wide entering the stretch but lacked a solid kick. QUANTICO HERO , four wide early, stalked the leaders three wide down the backstretch, failed to respond when roused leaving the far turn then faltered.
