FORESTIER, quickly clear, set the pace along the rail, drifted out near the sixteenth pole and surrendered. ASK QUEENIE lacked speed raced along the rail and passed tired ones. SILMARIL, wide, was no factor. SALTSTER raced along the rail entering the stretch and failed to rally. WILD BERRY chased the pace three wide and faltered. WAGE A PENNY raced well off the rail and faltered.
