LASTCALLFORDISCO cleared early, was well rated setting the pace inside, edged away in upper stretch, switched to his correct lead when roused left handed a furlong out, drifted out late and dug in gamely to hold sway. BID TIL INCLUDED rated kindly while saving ground, angled out when gathering momentum mid turn, ranged up four wide into the stretch, drifted out in the final furlong, finished gamely but just could not get past the winner. ALBRECHT was rated back leaving the chute and tracked the winner while saving ground, came under pressure while getting through inside into the lane, chased past the furlong pole and finished up willingly. ZARROC settled back after an alert start and saved ground, swung out four wide when advancing in upper stretch, chased past the eighth pole but lacked the needed late response. TIZ RELEVANT, three to four wide throughout, lacked a rally. NIGHT OFFICER stalked the winner two wide, remained a forward presence to upper stretch then tired. RAM was taken wide early, made a mild five wide run approaching the stretch then gave way. COURT BAND, three wide chasing the pace, faltered after five and a half furlongs then drifted out.
