PROUD FORTUNE , nicely rated leaving the backstretch, saved ground, eased outside in upper stretch, closed and drew off. SIR VINSKY advanced along the rail in the stretch, angled out near the sixteenth pole and rallied. FIVE STAR DESIGN dueled along the rail and weakened. BEAT THE CHALK disputed the pace two wide and gave way. PASTA chased the pace three wide and gave way. WAR BANDIT was outrun. SECOND COLLECTION was outrun. SWISSLE STICK chased the pace four wide and faltered.
